2020-2021 Basketball Contest Guidelines

Game Policies and Procedures for Fans and Teams

- Fans will enter and exit through the outside gym mall doors at the center of campus
- The doors will open 30 minutes prior to the start of the game and fans will not be admitted early
- Masks are required upon entry in the gymnasium, and must worn at all times in the gymnasium. The school reserves the right to ask anyone without a mask to leave.
- Social distancing must be maintained while attending games.
- Fans are to sit in designated areas only. No standing or congregating in the gym
- Fans will not congregate in common areas before, during, or after a game ends.
- As soon as the game ends fans must depart the gym.
- Fans should practice social distancing while leaving campus.
- 300 total tickets will be available to purchase. Tickets are first come, first serve
- Tickets will be \$6.00
- Concessions will be sold but items are limited
- AHSAA passes will be accepted; however, the school reserves the right to limit admission based space availability
- No outside food or drinks will be allowed
- There will be no passes out. If you leave out, you will not be allowed back in.
- Anniston High School cheerleaders will sit in their designated area only.
- Visiting Cheerleaders will be allowed; There is a section designated on the visiting side for seating
- Each team must adhere to their own school's policies on health screening of their athletes and coaches prior to entering the gymnasium.
- Only players, coaches, and trainers/support staff are allowed on the team bench.
- Coaches and players on the bench will wear masks at all times . Only players actively participating will be allowed to remove masks.
- Locker rooms will be available, but it is encouraged to show up to the game dressed to play.
- Each team must bring their own basketballs for warm up. Basketball will not be provided to you by Anniston High School.
- Each team must have their own water bottles. A cooler will be set up for refills.
- Per AHSAA guidelines, the player's bench, scorers table, locker rooms, and basketballs will be sanitized between each game.

These policies are subject to change as guidance from the Alabama Department of Public Health and the Alabama High School Athletic Association evolves over the course of the season.
