

STATE OF ALABAMA BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT

Under the Alabama Constitution, the State of Alabama is, in most circumstances, immune from lawsuits seeking monetary damages; consequently, the Board of Adjustment represents the only remedy for individuals or businesses seeking payment for damage done by the State of Alabama. The Alabama Legislature established the Board of Adjustment (“the Board”) “to provide a method of payment by the State of Alabama or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, institutions or departments to persons for injuries to person or property or for death occasioned by the State of Alabama or any of its agencies, commissions, boards, institutions or departments where in law, justice or good morals the same should be paid.” (See Code of Alabama §§ 41-9-60 through 41-9-74)
